

## QUESTIONS FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

## “CHRIST’S TRANSFORMING POWER”

MARK 5:1-20

APRIL 28, 2019

1. Jesus had previously cast out demons (1:25, 34) but why was this event especially significant?
2. In what ways was the Gerasene man beyond human help? How was his desperate situation symbolic of fallen humanity?
3. How can you recognize the reality of spiritual warfare but not live in fear of its destructive power?
4. Why did Jesus grant permission for the demons to enter the herd of pigs?
5. How does verse 15 give testimony to the transforming power of Christ?
6. Why did the crowd want Christ to leave their shores?
7. How can you help a “good” sinner to see their need for Christ?
8. How can you bear testimony to the grace of God and the transforming power of Christ?

Main point: Jesus demonstrates His authority over Satan’s forces of darkness by healing the Gerasene demoniac. Christ transforms your heart so that you will bear testimony to the grace and truth of God.
