QUESTIONS FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

- 1. How can you not lose by believing in Christ? What does it mean to have Christ as your Cornerstone?
- 2. What does Peter mean when he says Christ is "precious" to those who believe? How does this compare to verse 4 where Jesus "is choice and precious in the sight of God"?
- 3. How is conversion to Christ more than a decision to believe some facts about God? What does it mean to be born again?
- 4. The same stone that saves some causes others to stumble. Why is that?
