## “THE MASTER’S MEN AND METHOD”

MARK 3:13-19

FEBRUARY 24, 2019

1. How important was prayer to Christ’s choosing of the twelve? Why did Jesus pray before making His decision?
2. What does the Lord’s choice of His disciples mean for their future?
3. Why did Jesus choose twelve disciples? What is significant about the number?
4. Is Christ’s model of discipleship an example for us to follow?
5. Should every Christian be involved in “discipling” others? What does this mean?
6. Is every Christian called to a ministry? Why?
7. If Christ can accomplish His purpose through the lives of twelve common men, what can He do through your life?

Main point: Mark explains how Jesus chose twelve common men to be His disciples and carry on His work so that you understand His choice of you.
