

QUESTIONS FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

“THE POWER OF THE SERVANT KING”

MARK 1:29-39
DECEMBER 30, 2018

1. How does Jesus exhibit His total dominion over both the spiritual and physical realms? Why is this important?
2. In what way is man’s spiritual condition like Simon’s mother in law’s physical condition?
3. Simon’s mother-in-law was healed and immediately began serving Christ out of gratitude. What should be your response to the Lord’s healing touch in your heart?
4. What does this text reveal to you about Christ’s compassion?
5. In what ways are we able to minister like Jesus and in what ways are we limited?
6. How does Jesus’ power provide a foreshadowing of the glorious nature of His eternal kingdom from which all sorrow and disease will be banished forever?
7. How is regeneration and salvation a demonstration of Christ’s miraculous power today?
8. What is the source of Christ’s power? How was He fully dependent on the Father and the Spirit? How are you making this a priority in your life?
9. Why did Jesus leave Capernaum? How should His mission be reflected in your priorities?

Main point: Jesus demonstrates that He is the compassionate yet powerful Servant King. He casts out demons and heals diseases to validate that He is the Savior who came to rescue souls from sin and Satan. He wants you to trust and obey Him as He alone is the Servant King who possesses the power to impart eternal life and fit us for resurrected glory in heaven.
